1. Meeting called to order at 5:37 pm
2. Approve Minutes of April 23, 2026. Lucinda Sullivan made a motion to approve the minutes as presented and Dottie Guiffre seconded. The minutes were approved unanimously as presented. So moved.
3. Discussion about Roxbury Revitalization Project:
 - Elizabeth talked with VTrans. She said it was very helpful. Speed signs were up as of today's meeting. Crosswalk: Would need a sidewalk on both sides of the road in order to have a crosswalk put in. It was suggested to get a sign "Pedestrian Activity Ahead" as a way to slow down traffic,
 - Heidi reported on the ROCOR meeting. The recreation trail the length of Vermont is being worked on with a goal of making it adaptive for bicycles. It is up to Braintree Hill so far.
 - The state is redoing the Roxbury State Forest Management Plan.
 - History Walk: A lot of possibilities for the history walk through Roxbury. The goal is to get a draft of it done by 4th of July.
 - Municipal Planning Grant; Nate Donahue informed Elizabeth, Chair of RPC, that the Grant has been officially closed out. RPC could probably apply for another MPG in the 27-28 fiscal year.
 - Conference put on by the Preservation Trust in St Albans on June 4th, '26. Commissioners to look into it and consider going, Heidi is going.
